Participants will immerse themselves with the United Nation's Sustainable Development Goals to better understand how urban destinations can support these global goals. The varied roles of different stakeholders will be explored by learning how to initiate and implement sustainability in the urban tourism context. Students in this course will also examine the impact of unsustainable development practices and learn best practices by using Sunway City as a model.
